Support Letter: Assessment of critical biodiversity hotspots and cocoa livelihoods systems in and around Krokosua Hills Forest Reserve in the Western Region of Ghana for Green Development Initiative Certification.

The Krokusua Hills forest reserves is a repository of outstanding biodiversity and one of the most threatened forests in Ghana due mainly to unsustainable timber and agricultural production methods.
